1. Kamakura, Tsurugaoka Hachimangu and Komachi dori street Tour (Main language: Japanese and English)

Kamakura, 50km south of Tokyo, is the unique city, where the 'samurai', or warriors, for the first time in the history of Japan, established their government in the late 12th century, Tsurugaoka Hachimangu shrine founded in 1180 is the most gorgeous shrine in Kamakura attracting millions of visitors for its history, culture, architecture and various traditional events. The tour will also be visiting the latest Kamakura attractions, such as shops, places to eat, and sweets.

2. Kawasaki Japan Open Air Folk House Museum Tour (Main language: Japanese and English)

This tour visits Minkaen, or Japan Open-Air Folk House Museum, which exhibits 25 merchant and farmer houses originally built from 17th century to 20th century and moved from many parts of Japan. The tour visits inside of selected houses and finds daily life of people a hundred or more years ago in Japan.
