

Homestay Program in Kakuda, a Farmers Village

We are pleased to announce that Kakuda Homestay Program will be held again in February 2020.



Kakuda Homestay Program was started in 2009. Kakuda City is a farmers' village which is located in Miyagi Prefecture. We expect Tokyo Tech students, mostly live in urban areas such as Tokyo or Yokohama, to see “the other part of Japan” through this homestay program by experience the life in the countryside and interact with the people there.

Program overview.

- Date: **From Tuesday, February 25, 2020 to Friday February 28, 2020** (for 3 nights and 4 days)
- Required Qualification: Tokyo Tech international students (B, M, D, research students) or researchers
- Japanese Language Proficiency: No restriction
- Participation Fee: Approximately 15,500 yen including insurance (TBD)
*This includes the all of the necessary expenses, such as accommodation, party and transportation. Your personal expense during the tour is the only exception
