Katakana: One Part

阿	→	ア
伊	→	イ
宇	→	ウ
江	→	エ
於	→	オ

Tips for effective memorization

**Do not let them slide!

Karuta (かるた, from Portuguese carta ["card"]) are Japanese playing cards.

2 cards for each kana.

Playing card: Letter and picture

Reading card: Word or sentence starting with each letter
